Background:

The Board of Education recognizes that rural and French immersion bus students are required to stay for lunch.

Additionally, the Board of Education recognizes that remaining at school for lunch is sometimes appropriate for students who are not bussed. However, staying for lunch in these cases is a privilege.

Procedures:

1. The Board of Education recognizes that remaining at school over the noon hour is a privilege for students living in the school's attendance area. This privilege will be extended only to those students who act in a responsible manner.
2. Principals have the right to revoke lunch privileges for students who live in the attendance area whose behavior is inappropriate.
3. Every student who stays for lunch shall remain on the school premises. If a student wishes to leave the premises, permission is required from their parent(s)/guardian(s).
